PIX Pellet Nordic in brief

- PIX Pellet Nordic Index is a wood pellet price index concentrating on industrial use of pellets in Nordic countries
- Published since September 2009
- The index is calculated from prices of actual trades and both buyers and sellers of the products are represented as price providers in the index
- Publishing 3rd Tuesday of the following month at 12 noon Helsinki time, GMT +2 (following day if public holiday)
- Prices can be reported both per MWh and per ton. The index is published in EUR/SEK per MWh, the prices reported per ton are transformed into MWh
- More detailed specifications can be requested from FOEX Indexes Ltd.

Main uses of PIX Indices

- Possibility to hedge - through an exchange or bank/other financial institution - product or raw material price risk against a reliable index
- Basis for a price formation directly with a customer/supplier
- Basis for internal pricing/invoicing between profit centers (e.g. pulp mill to paper mill, liner board mill to box plant, wood to energy)
- Market research needs
- Useful reference tool, based on industry information, yet transparent and objective
- Source of up-to-date market information
- Any commercial use of PIX indices requires a license agreement with FOEX, the owner of the PIX trademark
